ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2008-13

RE: Indian River County Circuit Court Clerk Ad Interim

WHEREAS, the Clerk of the Circuit Court in and for Indian River County, Jeffrey K. Barton, has announced his retirement effective midnight, November 30, 2008, and;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Constitution of the State of Florida and Florida Statutes, the office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court is required to be filled at all times, and;

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Florida has not made an appointment to the office of clerk of the circuit court in and for Indian River County as a result of the pending retirement of Jeffrey K. Barton, Clerk of Court in and for Indian River County before the end of his term, and;


WHEREAS, section 28.09, Florida Statutes requires that the judge of that court appoint a *clerk ad interim* in the case of a vacancy in the office of the clerk of the circuit court by death, resignation, or other cause, and;

THEREFORE pursuant to the power vested in the chief judge pursuant to rule 2.215, Florida Rules of Judicial Administration and section 28.09, Florida Statutes,

It is Ordered that Mary Louise Scheidt is appointed as *clerk ad interim* in and for Indian River County and shall assume all of the responsibilities, perform all the duties, and receive the same compensation for the time being as if she had been duly appointed to fill the office. Ms. Scheidt shall give such bond and security for the faithful performance of duties as required by the board of county commissioners.

This interim appointment shall be effective at 12:00 A.M., December 1, 2008 and shall continue until the elected clerk of the circuit court is sworn in, on January 5, 2009.
