
IN RE: APPOINTMENT OF CIVIL INFRACTION AND PARKING

**WHEREAS;** the Supreme Court has previously approved the Civil Traffic Infraction and Parking Ticket Violations Hearing Officer Program for Saint Lucie and Martin Counties; and

**WHEREAS;** the interest of the public litigants, and the judiciary require a flexible and speedy system of the civil traffic infractions and parking ticket violations; and as Chief Judge pursuant to Rule 6.630(a)(c), Florida Rules of Traffic Court, and Administrative Order numbers 2000-14 and 2001-17, it is therefore;

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that Curtis L. Disque, a member in good standing of the Florida Bar is hereby appointed as Civil Infraction Hearing Officer for Saint Lucie and Martin counties of the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit.
