PUBLIC DEFENDERS, AND PRIVATE ATTORNEYS**


As a result of the State and Federal Corona Virus initiatives, orders, and guidelines, Florida Supreme Court Orders AOSC20-12, AOSC20-13 and 19<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit Administrative Order 2020-01 this judge is Ordering the Waiver of Appearances/Attendance at Docket Call of all Defendants that are assigned to his division for the purposes of the Court's March 24 and 25, 2020, April 22 and 23 and May 26 and 27 Docket Calls.

All cases set for the March 24 and 25 Docket Calls are continued to May 26, 2020 Docket Call at 9 a.m. as to private attorneys and May 27, 2020 for Public Defenders (unless otherwise previously ordered by the Court in separate case orders).

The Court will be utilizing Court Call for the April and May Docket calls. The Court has waived the personal appearances of all defendants as to the April and May docket calls (see above).

All telephone appearances for the April and May docket calls must be made through CourtCall, a company which provides connection between the parties and the courtroom for a flat fee, or any third party provider that the Court can access. When you know the date and time of your hearing you **must call CourtCall directly at 1-888-882-6878 Ext. 870** to arrange for your appearance by phone. You must schedule your CourtCall appearance at least three (3) working days prior to the hearing.
