This holiday schedule is the same as the holiday schedule established by the Supreme Court of Florida for calendar year 2022. Per the State Courts System Personnel Regulation 4.07 (1) if a holiday falls on Saturday, the preceding Friday shall be observed as a holiday. If a holiday falls on Sunday, the following Monday shall be observed as a holiday. Therefore, New Year's Day is observed on Friday, December 31, 2021 and Christmas Day is observed on Monday, December 26, 2022. Furthermore, in accordance with State Courts System Personnel Regulation 4.07(2) one additional workday may be designated as a holiday. As such, Christmas Eve will be observed Friday, December 23, 2022, for Nineteenth Judicial Circuit officers and employees.

\*\*Denotes a discretionary holiday established by the chief justice and chief judge in accordance with State Courts System Personnel Regulation 4.07(2).

During holiday(s) designated by the Counties: The Court in the respective County(ies) will remain open, however, County buildings will be closed. Therefore, court events will not be scheduled on these days.
