Each party is responsible for having their witnesses in the Zoom Virtual Waiting Room at the scheduled time, where they will remain until admitted by the Court to give testimony. Witnesses who do not appear on camera; and are not present with a Notary Public will not be permitted to testify. At the time of the hearing, all participants must be in a quiet place, without interruption from children, pets or other noises or distractions.

ALL EVIDENCE MUST BE SCANNED AND EMAILED TO THE CLERK, ALL PARTIES AND THE COURT **at least 3 business days (72 hours)** in advance of your hearing.

If you have a dissolution of marriage final hearing, you **must** scan and email a copy of your Florida driver's license, Florida ID card, voter's registration or Affidavit of Corroborating Witness. To change your name to a former or maiden name, you will need to appear remotely or provide an affidavit of name change.
